Prolonged arrest. Significant downtime, remains in PEA, elderly patient with limited mobility. D/W family and crew - resuscitation terminated on scene. ["Advanced life support"]

Haemodynamically stable, lower back, hip and right shoulder pain. Skin loss to back. Stripped to pants (helmet and full Kevlar bike kit), binder, immobilised, access, analgesia. Remained stable and paramedic crew happy, so I pre-alerted via trauma desk to UHW and crew conveyed. Delay to scene due to significant traffic blocking road due to accident

No further casualties found. I was not booked on but was tipped off about incident by BB who had been tasked from Cowbridge because EMRTS (initially) not available.
